

2025 Ice Show: Back to the Future

LTS Registration

The IceWorks Skating Club's annual ice show is the largest club-sponsored and run event. It serves as the club's sole and most significant fundraiser every year, but most importantly, it provides skaters of every level a special opportunity to showcase their skills and talents for friends, family, and the local community. Our skaters work very hard all year long and this is their chance to celebrate that dedication and commitment.

The theme of the 2025 Annual Ice Show is **Back to the Future.** Show dates are:

Friday May 9th Saturday May 10th Sunday May 11th 7:00pm 7:00pm 4:00pm

How It Works:

- There are two LTS numbers in the show:
 - Option 1 rehearses on Wednesdays at 7:00pm-7:30pm beginning March 12th.
 - Option 2 rehearses on Sundays at 12:30pm-12:50pm beginning March 16th.
- LTS skaters are eligible to skate in either one or both of these numbers.
- To register, use the attached form to select the number(s) your skater wants to participate in based on when your skater can rehearse. Show Directors determine songs after registration is complete. Skaters will be notified at that time of their song and its Act 1 or Act 2 placement.

Rehearsals:

- Rehearsals are held on Wednesday evenings or Sunday afternoons for approximately 6 weeks.
- Each rehearsal is 30 minutes. Skaters are expected to attend all rehearsals and to be prompt.
- There are no rehearsals on April 16th, April 23rd or April 20th due to the Easter holiday.
- Currently, there is currently no planned rehearsal for Sunday May 4th. If an additional rehearsal is needed for either or both numbers, it will be held on Sunday May 4th. The Sunday group would rehearse from 12:30pm-12:50pm and the Wednesday group from 12:50pm-1:20pm.

Skaters are also required to attend the following dress rehearsals the week before the show:

Registration & Cost:

- Registration fee is due at the time of registration:
 - o \$90 for one number
 - \$165 for two numbers
- This covers the cost of the ice time, coaching and lesson fees, choreography, and costumes.

Costumes:

- Costumes are selected and purchased by the Show Directors. Cost is included in your registration.
- They are yours to keep after the show.
- As soon as costumes are available, you will be notified via e-mail about fitting times and pick-up.

<u>Ticket Requirements:</u>

• Every LTS skater is required to sell a minimum of 6 tickets, prior to the first dress rehearsal.

T-Shirts, Cast Posters, Printed Good Luck Wishes, & Program Ads:

- The following items are also available for purchase at the time of registration:
 - Show T-Shirts souvenir t-shirts with the show logo (\$25 per shirt)
 - Personalized Cast Poster displayed in the rink during the entire show weekend, for fans to write messages/well wishes (\$5 per poster)
 - Good Luck Wishes personal messages to skaters printed in the show program (\$7 per message)
- Program advertising is also available in 3 sizes: business card (\$25), half page (\$50), full page (\$100). Skaters who sell \$100s worth of program ads earn a free show t-shirt.

Rules/Expectations:

- Skaters are strongly encouraged to miss no more than one rehearsal. Our show is put together in a very short period, and we need all skaters' undivided attention and full commitment to ensure they are comfortable and prepared for opening night.
- All absences must be communicated to the coach and Show Directors prior to any missed rehearsals.
- Poor behavior cannot be not tolerated. If behavior is disruptive, skaters may be asked by the coach or Show Directors to sit out during rehearsal and/or may be removed from the number.
- In the event that a skater is removed or drops from a number, no refund will be granted.
